1. Executive summary

To achieve the overall objective of the project, i.e. to improve the effectiveness of cross-border firefighting and to allow an easy and secure transfer of human and material resources from one country to another, it is necessary to have a fluent communication between experts from different countries and the dissemination of its results.

In the MEFISTO project, "Communication and dissemination" has been defined as another task, establishing a series of essential actions to inform, exchange and disseminate knowledge on forest fire suppression and cross-border collaboration.

In the last decade, the improvement of EU countries co-operation in civil protection assistance interventions in the event of major emergencies has become one of a major priority. Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC), established in 2013, is daily working to reach this goal. Among the other, forest fires are civil protection events that yearly affect several EU countries, mainly in the Mediterranean area. Over the last two decades in southern Europe, more than 10 million hectares of forest have been damaged by fire. Each fire-fighting season incurs significant costs, measurable principally in terms of loss of human life, investment in fire-fighting resources, damage to the environment and infrastructures, and cost for recovering the burned areas. In the last decades, the deployment of expert, team and equipment, among the member States in occasion of severe fire seasons in one of the member state has increased (e.g. Canada sent to Greece from other countries in 2009 and 2013). At the same time, EU exercise on forest fire-fighting were organized (e.g. Sardinia 2008, Prometheus 2014) thus highlighting the needs of a co-ordination and collaboration improvement on forest fire response capacity at EU level. In this context, MEFISTO project aims to raise preparedness level through an efficient and standardized training protocol developed by a representative network of Mediterranean stakeholders. This project will address new opportunities regarding interoperability between Mediterranean training centres, allowing international cooperation against disasters related with forest fire. The project aims at establishing training programmes with specific sessions on the organization, protocols and procedures applied in the neighbouring countries in order to improve the effectiveness on cross-border fire-fighting and to allow an easy and safe transfer of human and material facilities from a country to another.

OBJECTIVES

The general aim of the project is the development of procedures for improving efficiency and effectiveness of forest fire-fighting at European level increasing the collaboration capacity among countries, developing common high quality standards in fire-fighting training systems, and sharing knowledge.

EXPECTED RESULTS

The planned activities will guarantee the development of a network among involved countries for sharing the development of a coordination to facilitate a coherent European response during forest fire emergencies made Europe.


The main expected results will be:

SIX EUROPEAN ENTITIES LAUNCH THE EUROPEAN FOREST FIRE FIGHTING COUNCIL

The headquarters of the Escola Nacional de Bombeiros (ENB), partner of the MEFISTO project, hosted recently a meeting of this European initiative, aimed at improving the European collaboration and coordination capacity in the fight against forest fires. The result of this work meeting was also the creation of the European FORest FIRE fighting Council (EUFORFIRE), which will serve to disseminate the practices and results obtained through the collaborative work and knowledge transfer of MEFISTO. The EUFORFIRE network also aims to involve European training centers in the field of prevention and training in the fight against forest fires.

The main objectives of EUFORFIRE concern:

- Sharing organizational models applied in the Parties' Countries and share their developments
- Collaborating for exchanging and training methods and skill evaluation procedures in the forest firefighting
- Developing and defining the minimum basic knowledge and skills to be developed in the training courses for similar position and command chain
- Improving mutual collaboration especially in the fields of big fire management and health and safety of forest firefighters

In 2017, the website had 509 users with 870 sessions. The main countries from which these users came were Italy, Spain, Portugal and Canada. They also visited the website of users from the United States, France, Brazil, Turkey, etc.

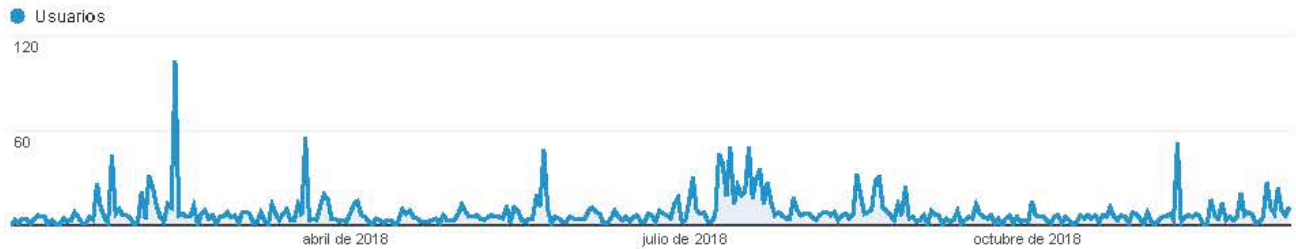
In 2018, the number of users increased considerably. This increase is logical, since most of the results were already uploaded on the web. The largest number of visits come once again from Portugal, Italy and Spain, with a considerable number of users in the United States. French users also increased in this last year.

In the previous graphs, where the general aspects of the audience of the website are summarized, we see that more than 85% are new users. Recurring users do not reach 15%, so we must consider attracting other users who already visited us. This will probably change when we upload the latest results of the project, since they are a very important part of them.

Regarding the number of page visits, it increased considerably from 2017 to 2018, with a bounce rate of less than 50%. This percentage assesses the quality of the visits. The bounce rate tells us how our site is working, the lower the bounce rate, the better the quality of the traffic and the greater the likelihood that the objectives will be met. If you have a bounce rate close to 100%, users would only access the main page, without being interested in the contents. We have less than 50%, hoping that this percentage will decrease when the last results are uploaded.

Another important value is the pages per session. The objective is that the number of page views exceed the number of sessions achieved as much as possible. Our value is 3.6 pages per session, so it is a good value.

On the other hand, there is the duration of the visit. A medium high time means that the content of the website is of good quality. A desirable duration would be about five minutes, although it depends on the type of web and the type of content, but if the average is less than one minute, the visitor is not being convinced. The average duration of the session on the MEFISTO website is about three minutes, being an acceptable value.

Below are the most visited events in the two years of the project. All the information appears in Annex I.

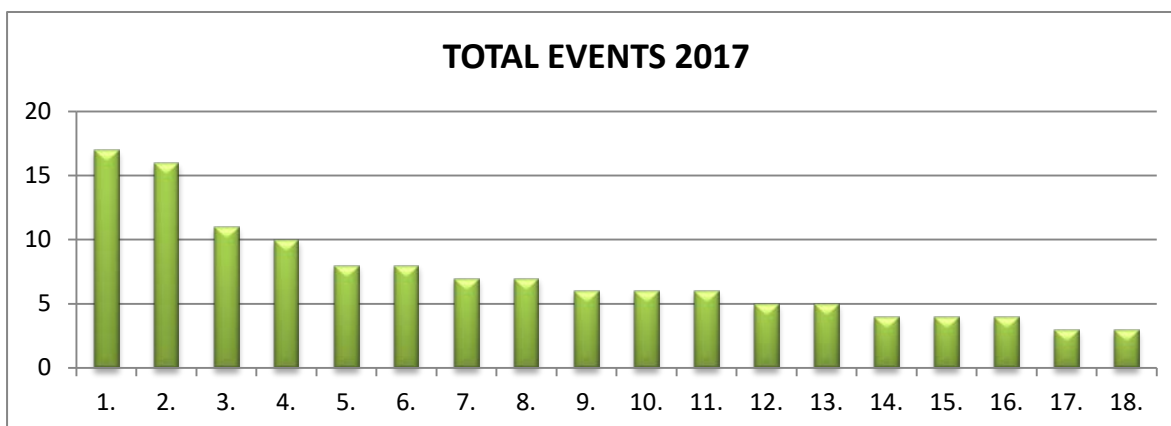

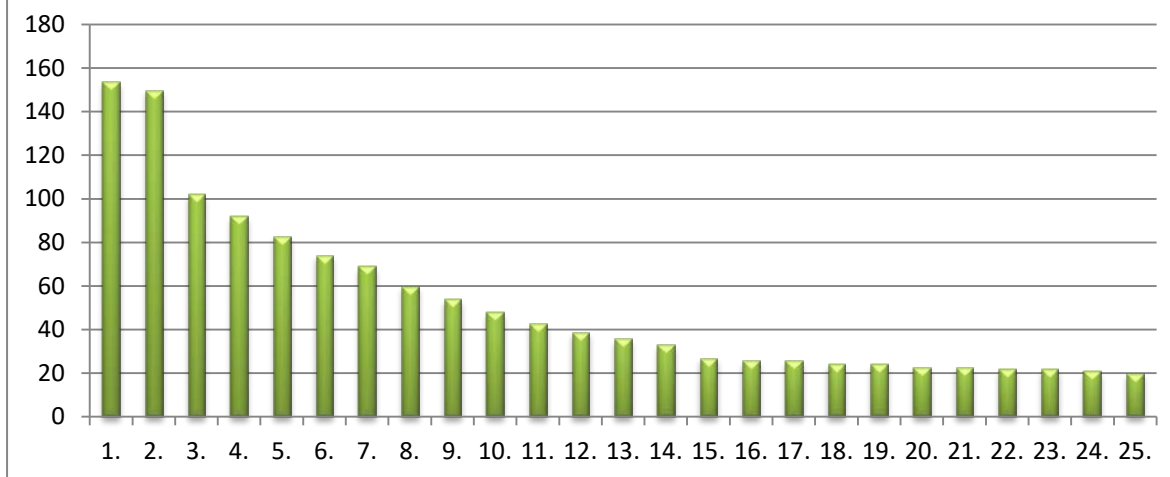

4. Dissemination activities

The dissemination activities guarantee the visibility and knowledge of the project, making its results known to the forestry sector, the scientific and industrial community. In addition, the results of the project will be published in the newspapers, reaching the general public. The dissemination activities will ensure the dissemination of the "EUropean FORest FIRE fighting Council" (EUFORFIRE) to involve other interested parties from other European countries in the association.


4.1. List of stakeholders

4.3. Glossary APP

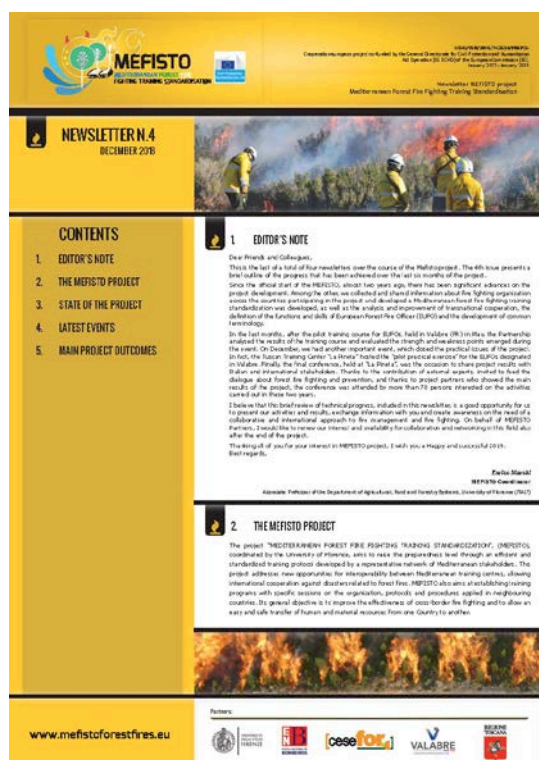
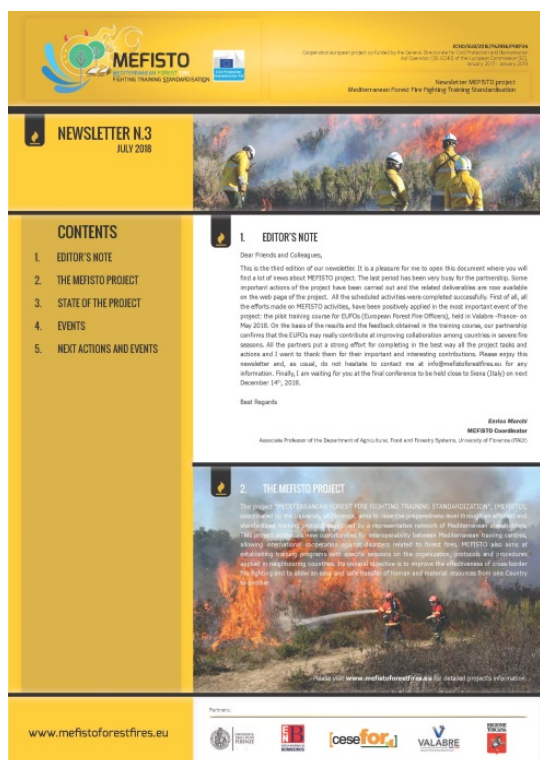
One of the most important results of the project has been the development of the multilingual glossary on forest fire fighting. The glossary required a strong effort to all partners, and results have been appreciated internationally. Two formats were created to disseminate the glossary, a classic printable document, freely available in .pdf, and a freely downloadable App for smartphones available for both Android and iOS systems. The App has been really appreciated, and it could be really useful also during emergencies.

Since the last update of the application, in October 2018, there have been about 150 effective installations, according to the official google play source: <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.app.mefisto>. A similar number of installations have been made in apple store for the IOS system.

4.4. MEFISTO newsletters publication

A newsletter has been published every six months to provide brief information on the status and progress of the project. In total, four newsletters have been developed and are available for download on the website.





4.5. Roll-up and Brochure

Another dissemination activity has consisted of the preparation of an informative brochure. 500 paper units were distributed to each partner. It is also available in electronic format on our website to reach the maximum audience.

For public exhibitions and meetings, a MEFISTO poster was also created, which is also available on our website.

- The reduction of guidelines and reports with the description of the organization, strategies and methods applied in each Country. These documents will contain the protocols and procedures applied in neighboring Countries in order to improve the efficiency of cross border fire fighting.
- The definition of the standards in fire fighting training system which can be applied in all partners Countries (training assessment, assessment methods, score sheets).
- The promotion of new initiatives of training in all the involved structures.
- The development of an European qualifications of European Forest Fire personnel.
- The institution of a European permanent network with the aim of develop and guarantee the international standard assessment of firefighter skills.

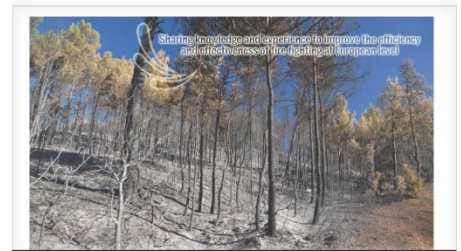

5. Final Conference

The final conference, which was held in the Tuscan training center (La Pineta) on December 14th, counted around 70 participants, which is a very good result in terms of participation. At the end of this first part, the theme of the conference moved on the specific aspects of MEFISTO project. During this second part of the event, several members of all project partners made presentations on specific results of the project.

6. Conclusions

The dissemination actions carried out aim to guarantee the visibility and knowledge of the project and support the wider adoption of its results. These actions have been established according to a Communication Plan whose objective is to raise awareness of the need to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of forest fire fighting at European level, increasing collaboration between countries, sharing knowledge and involving society in prevention.

After the analysis of these actions, it can be concluded that it has been achieved in part, since the impact can not be measured one hundred percent.

Despite this, it is important the interest that has caused the "Forest Fires Multilingual Glossary" and its app, as well as the "European Procedure for Forest Fire Fighting", among other generated documents.

Results as important as those related to the pilot course of the "European Forest Fire Officer" EUFO, will be uploaded to the web in the month of January 2019, and are essential to examine the effect of the project on the scientific community and the public in general.

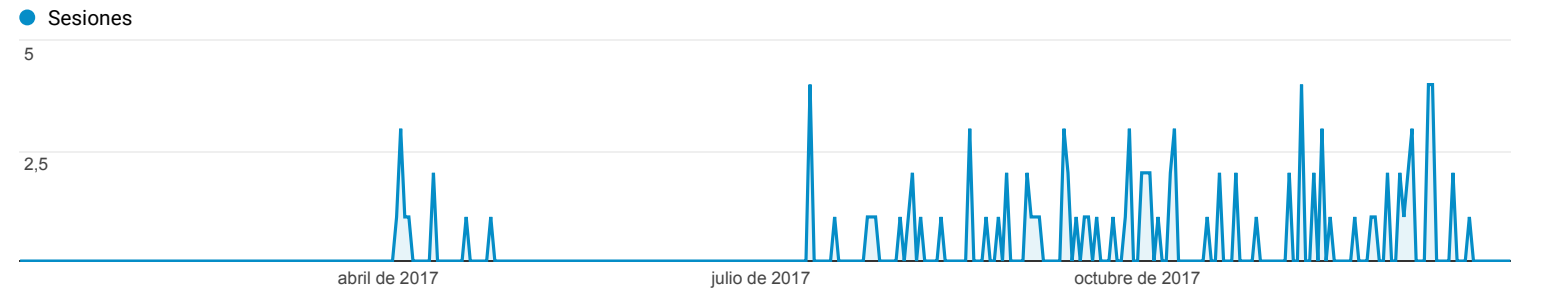

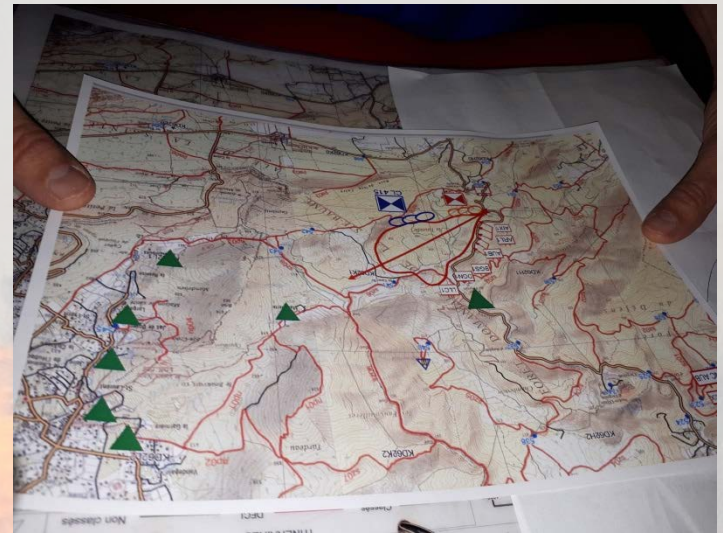
